Entry Guidelines

Share your Eco-Art in digital form for the week of the Student Environmental Action Showcase! NoVA Outside invites K-12 students to share artwork that inspires environmental action through a **positive message, image, or story** – to be featured on the SEAS virtual gallery website and through social media during the virtual SEAS week of May 2-7.

Digital media submissions may include:

- Video: short film, animation, virtual tour of a project
- Audio: songs, podcasts, spoken word
- Graphic art: illustration, comic, photography, infographic, poster
- Writing: poetry, essay or short story

Guidelines for the SEAS Eco-Art submissions:

1. Submissions should be digital audio, video, text, or picture files, either linked content that is available to the public (as with YouTube, vimeo, flickr, etc) or submitted separately via email. Accepted media file formats: MP3 audio, MP4 video, PDF, jpg, png, or gif. For emailed files, the **file size is not to exceed 20 megabytes**
2. Audio/video recordings should be short and concise, but there is no set limit (videos, for example, are more likely to be viewed when under two minutes). Aim for impact, not length
3. Submitted digital art/media must be original work, created by the student(s) submitting it
4. Submissions may be in any language, as long as an English-language translation is provided, either as subtitles or as a separate text file
5. Submissions should not contain foul language, and should be consistent with the student's school's guidelines for expression. Make your message positive!
6. The submitted media file may include music, sounds, visuals, animation, or other effects, and the **speaker(s)/author(s) is/are not required to appear in video**
7. Submitted media must be accompanied by the signed parental consent/release form (following page)

Entries should be submitted on the SEAS event page at www.novaoutside.org, and must be received by May 1, 2022.

By providing participant's personal information, such as name or email at time of submission, including the personal information of youth participant younger than EIGHTEEN years of age, I understand that NoVA Outside may use such information to communicate with participant for the purposes of administering the SEAS Eco-Art exhibition and complying with applicable laws, regulations and rules.
