

## **Student Environmental Action Showcase Eco Art Photo Contest 2019**

**Who is Eligible:** Any student in grade K-6. Schools and organizations-please limit your entries to 3 per age category.

**Age Categories:** Grades K-2; grades 3-4; grades 5-6

**Subject Matter:** Tell a story of positive change and effort by young environmentalists. Please submit a photo that depicts work you are doing at your school or in your community to instill positive change.

### **Photo Requirements:**

- Photos must be original work of student or student team.
- No signatures or lettering that will identify an individual student can appear in the photo.
- Photographer must have the permission of each person in the photo.
- All photos will become the property of NoVA Outside. The guardian of the student, allows a non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to publish your student's/team's artwork in NoVA Outside or George Mason University editorial, educational, and promotional print and digital materials, in our promotional and educational posts to social media, and for all other lawful uses to promote NoVA Outside's mission. **Under no circumstances will the image be sold or used for commercial purposes.**

### **Submitting Photos:**

- Photos will be submitted electronically by **April 5, 2019**. Late entries will not be eligible for prizes.
- Photos must be registered and submitted through the google form accessed here <https://goo.gl/forms/q2tT0wEJZCBHe1xB3>.
- Submitted photos should be **no larger than 10mb**.

### **Judging:**

All entries will be displayed at the SEAS event on April 23, 2019.

An amazing panel of judges will select winners from the categories and prizes will be awarded at the SEAS closing ceremony. The artist(s) does/do not need to be in attendance to win.

There will be three prizes in each of the three age categories:

- Most Inspirational
- Most Hilarious
- Most Creative

**Prizes:** Each winning photo will receive a certificate and a \$25 gift card to purchase artistic supplies for future work.
